The Cushman School recently launched its #ONEMOREPARENT movement, which provides parents with tangible actions they can do in their homes to ensure a healthy growth mindset in their children. In response to our country's epidemic of violence, increasing childhood anxiety, depression and isolation, this movement is meant to instill empathy and love by preserving childhood and foster greater connections among family members while eliminating violence and minimizing excessive use of electronics. Interested parents are asked to sign the **#ONEMOREPARENT** pledge, which includes acts like: disposing of violent video games, eating at least one meal a day together when possible and monitoring social media accounts (middle and high school students). Cushman's Head of School, Arvi Balseiro, explains that this methodology has always been part of Cushman's culture, but the recent school shootings in Parkland promoted the school's administration to create this platform to initiate action among Cushman parents and to share with other parents in our community. One of the first **#ONEMOREPARENT** events at The Cushman School was the "Violent Video Game Toss" that
