



Individualized Artistic Education

Barry University's (Barry) Fine Arts Department prides itself on focusing each student's abilities to their maximum potential. Their primary goal stays intent on the student's future involvement with or employment in the visual and performing arts.

Silvia Lizama, the Fine Arts Department's Chair is understandably proud of the school.

The long-tenured professors are professional entertainers or artists, still practicing or performing. The campus has four exhibit and performance venues: Shepard and Ruth K. Broad Center for the Performing Arts presenting opera, concerts and theatre performances, seating 970 guests; Pelican, Black Box space presenting new works, drama and cabaret, seating 45; Cor Jesu Chapel for recitals seating 200 and the Andy Gato Gallery for photography and art exhibitions, as well as music recitals.

The program also utilizes cross-curriculum practices with interdisciplinary layers including the English, Communications, Biology, Criminology and Education departments. Barry offers small class sizes, one on one attention from a committed faculty and the latest in creative resources. Internships within the Greater South Florida community are encouraged for students to sharpen their skills and gain practical experience.



Theatre and Dance:

These two disciplines lead students into performance, and technical training including costume, make-up and stage

production. The Theater Program has forged working relationships with many professional theatre companies. including City Theatre, Zoetic Stage, Wilton Theater Factory, Broward Stage Door and GableStage. Accomplished graduates are now employed with both City Theatre and the national tour of A Bronx Tale. The Theatre faculty are seasoned professionals who have instructed many theatrical themes, concepts and methods.



The Dance Program includes ballet, modern, jazz, Latin and Afro-Caribbean forms. The annual dance productions draw large crowds from both the university community and the ethnically diverse neighborhoods surrounding the campus. Graduates have gone into dance education, established dance schools, as well as performing as independent artists.

Fulltime Faculty include John Manzelli and Dr. Hugh Murphy, Theatre and Yvonne Goodridge, Dance.



Music:

Barry's formal music training aims students to prestigious opportunities. The department produces two major performances each year featuring both voice and instrumentals. The program's ultimate goal is guiding students to rewarding employment such as teaching, choral conducting and performance. The world-class Music faculty all practice their craft and maintain active performance schedules, both nationally and internationally.

Photography, Graphic Design, Studio Art and Art History:

A standout among universities, Barry's photography program maintains traditional darkroom methods, as well as the latest in digital technology. With two computer labs and three darkrooms. students are immersed in a variety of printing methodologies: vintage processes such as cyanotypes, van dyke browns and tintypes are enhanced through digitally produced negatives. The programs newest equipment addition is an aerial photography drone.

A popular Biomedical and Forensic Photography Specialization offers opportunities for students interested in this field.

Barry University also offers a Masters of Arts and Master of Fine Arts degrees in Photography.

Fulltime Faculty in Photography: Tracie Heller, Silvia Lizama, Sara Rytteke, and Scott Weber.




